Introduction Lesson	Answer short questions - what's your name, age, present themselves
Numbers 1-20 and tens up to 100	Learn to count to 20 and tens up to 100
Days of the week	Learn the days of the week
Months of the year	Learn the months of the year
Seasons	Learn the seasons
Morning routines	Learing the morning routine and learn related verbs
Pets	Learn pets vocabulary and have simple answers - "Do you have any?", "I have ", "Yes, I do / No, I don't"
Describing People: Adjectives	Answering to "What does s/he look like?", "Tell me all about him/her", "She/she is/has"
Describing Things: Adjectives	Answering to "Let's look at~", "What's that?", "It's a/an big / small, etc
Telling the time	Answering to "What time is it?", "Please could you tell me the time?", "It's _ o'clock"
Daily Routines & Times of the Day	answering to "I at (8 o'clock in the morning)", "What time do you?", "When do you?"
Subject Pronouns (I, you, he, she, we, they]	answering "Who is?", "I am", "you are", "he is", "she is", "we are", "they are", "who is", "I/you/we/they like", "he / she likes"
Sports	answering to "What sports do you play?", "I play ~" and "I don't play ~", "To play (tennis) you have to (hit a tennis ball)."
Sports adjectives	answering to "Let's ~", "What shall we do?" with run, quickly, walk, slowly, jump, high, etc
Transport and travel	answering "How Did You Get Here Today?", "I got here on foot / by" on foot, bus, bicycle, car, train, boat, airplane, etc
Places & Where We Live	answering "Where do you live?", "Where does (a cow) live?", "I live (in/on)", "It lives (in/on)" sea, farm, forest, desert, cave, lake, mountain, river, city, town, village, etc
Places in my Town	answering "Where are you going?", "Where are you going right now?", "I'm going to~", "Over here" with school, the park, the shops, the beach, my friend's house, etc
Jobs	
Health & Sickness	answering to "What's wrong?", "What's the matter with you?", "I have a/an" with a headache, a cough, a stomachache, a sore throat, a runny nose, an earache, a cold, etc
Rooms of a House	answering to "What room is this?", "Where in the house do you?", "Do you have a/an [sofa]?" or "Have you got a/an [sofa]?" with house, bedroom, kitchen, bathroom, living room, dining room, garden, etc
Prepositions of Location	answering "Where is/are?", "Is it?, "Are they?", "It is", "They are" with on, under, in, behind, next to, in front of, between

Demonstrative pronouns (this / that / these / those)	answering to "What is this / that / that over there?", "What are these / those / those over there?" pointing to different objects (vocabulary already known)
Shopping and money	answering to "May I help you?", "Yes, please", "Here you are", "Thank you". "How is is/are?", "Do you have (Have you got) a/any?", "Do you want or?", "That's expensive!", "I'll take it!"
Actions - Present Continuous	answering to "What are you doing?", "I am", "He is", "She is", "They are" with running, cooking, eating, swimming, walking, drinking, drawing, etc
Adverbs of frequency	answering to "Do you?", "How often do you?" with always, almost always, often, usually, sometimes, rarely, hardly ever, almost never, never
Past Tense Activities - Regular Verbs	answering to "What did you do yesterday?", "Yesterday, I [verb+ed"]
Measuring Parts of the Body	Reviewing parts of the body, using large numbers (0 to over 100), using adjectives to describe size (long, tall), comparing size (the tallest, the shortest, the longest). Answering to I am / You are com tall", "My/Your (hair/arms/etc.) is/are cm long", "How tall am I?", "How long is my?"
Favorites and Asking Why	Answering to "What is your favorite / least favorite?", "Why is it your favorite / least favorite ?", "Because it is (adjective)"
Comparing Things (Comparative Adjectives)	We'll do easy sentences with "This is smaller" (adj + er), "That is more beautiful" (more + adj), etc
Comparing Things (Superlative Adjectives)	We'll do easy sentences using "This is the smallest" (the + adj+est), "That is the most beautiful" (the + most + adj)
Time Frequency - "How often?"	answering to "How often do you?", "never", "once", "twice", "[3] times", "every day", "a week", "a month", "a year"
Future Plans using "going to"	answering to "What are you going to do (this/next weekend / during the summer)?", "I'm (not) going to" with play a sport, go swimming, go abroad, meet my friends, visit relatives, etc
